

V. The Results of the Edification Complex (general)

- A. The Word of Truth is Applied: Epignosis ex-  
haled out the right and left bank of the soul.  
This is production of divine good. This is  
the salt and light principle. Eph. 4:23, 24;  
Matt. 5:13-16.
- B. The Glory of God is Reflected: Any reference  
to "light" or "lights" on the part of be-  
lievers is applicable here. 1 John 1:7;  
Philippians 2:15 and many, many other passages.
- C. The Stability of the Believer is Apparent:  
Colossians 2:7, "Rooted and built up in Him,  
and stabiished in the faith, as ye have been  
taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."
- D. The Stockpiling of Epignosis in the human  
spirit (a spiritual IQO. Eph. 3:19.
- E. The Christian Fulfills the Purpose for which  
he is on Earth. 2 Cor. 13:10, 11. The whole  
issue in the Christian life is edification  
or destruction. Destruction does not mean  
loss of salvation in this passage but no  
erection of an edification complex, instead  
rubble, stubble--building an edification com-  
plex with pseudo-building materials. 1 Cor. 3  
indicates that the building must have the  
proper materials.
